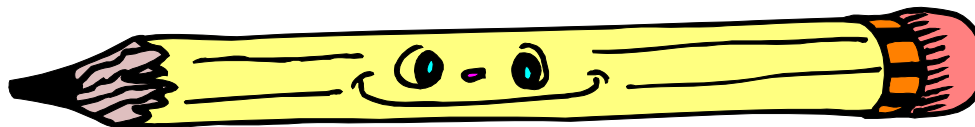


I'm the Artist!



Step-by-step, we are going to write a song, using the five notes that we have learned.
(Be sure to use a pencil!)

1. Draw a treble clef sign at the beginning of each staff line that you will use.
2. Write the time signature for four counts at the beginning of the first line.
3. Using the rhythm pattern on page 52, create a sentence that fits the pattern.
4. Draw two measures on page 51, using quarter notes choosing from *do*, *re*, *mi*, *fa* and *sol*. (Make sure there are four quarter notes in the first measure and three notes and a rest in the second measure.)
5. Write your words under the corresponding notes.
6. Put a double bar line and a repeat sign at the end.
7. Select a title for your song and write it at the top.
8. Play and sing *solfege* on your piano.
9. Play and sing the words.
10. Perform your song for your friends and family, because **you** are an artist!
