


Turning on Original Sound for Musicians

GENERAL NOTE:

Before turning on “*Original Sound for Musicians*”, make sure you have the **latest version of Zoom** installed.

iPad & iPhone

1. **Open the Zoom app.**
2. Tap **Settings** (bottom right).
3. Tap **Meetings**.
4. Scroll down and turn ON **Use Original Sound**.
5. Go back and start or join a meeting.
6. Tap **More (•••)** in the top right.
7. Tap **Enable Original Sound**.

 You will now see “Original Sound: On” at the top left when it's enabled.

Android Phones

1. **Open the Zoom app.**
2. Tap **Settings** (bottom right).
3. Tap **Meeting**.
4. Find and turn ON **Use Original Sound**.
5. Join or start a meeting.

6. Tap **More (three dots)** in the bottom right.
7. Tap **Enable Original Sound**.

 You'll see a notice at the top that "Original Sound" is ON.



Mac Computers

1. **Open the Zoom desktop app.**
2. Click your **profile picture** (top right) and go to **Settings**.
3. Click **Audio**.
4. Scroll down and check the box for **Show in-meeting option to enable "Original Sound for Musicians"**.
5. (Optional) Check the boxes for:
 - **High fidelity music mode**
 - **Echo cancellation**
 - **Stereo audio**
6. Close settings.
7. Start or join a meeting.
8. Click **Original Sound for Musicians: Off** at the top left to **turn it ON**.

 When it says "Original Sound for Musicians: On", you're good to go.



Windows Computers

1. **Open the Zoom desktop app.**

2. Click your **profile picture** (top right) and go to **Settings**.
3. Click **Audio**.
4. Scroll down and check **Show in-meeting option to enable "Original Sound for Musicians"**.
5. (Optional) Also check:
 - **High fidelity music mode**
 - **Echo cancellation**
 - **Stereo audio**
6. Close settings.
7. Start or join a meeting.
8. Click the button at the top left: **Original Sound for Musicians: Off** to **turn it ON**.

 You'll know it's working when it says "Original Sound for Musicians: On".
